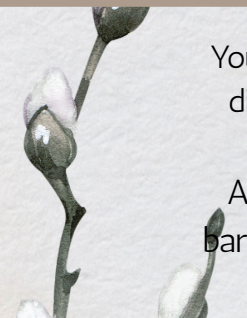

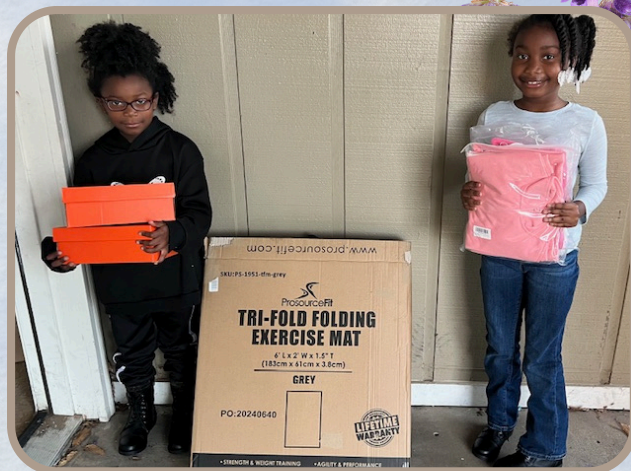


MEET ANIYA & AMINA
